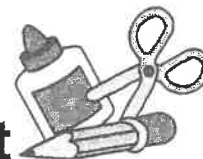

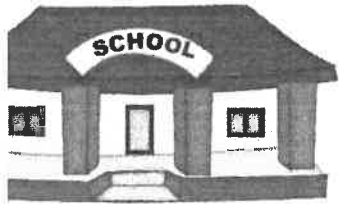
Congratulations! Your child has successfully completed Kindergarten and now it is time for them to move on to FIRST GRADE!
