Dear Families,

We are currently enrolling students in the Empire State After School Program for the 2018-2019 school year. Completed applications are due to the ESASP office by **August 15, 2018.** 

Students **grades K-5** will be eligible to apply to participate in the program. The program will be held five days a week from 2:15 p.m. – 5:15 p.m. Program will close on 10:20 dismissal days as well as Parent Teacher Conference days. Alternative options will be available for care on those days offered on a first come first serve basis. You may inquire with your school's enrichment provider for details.

#### Important information:

- Students in grades 2-5 can be transported from the after school program if they are currently receiving transportation from the District. However, please note that if accepted into the program, after school program time will replace their regularly scheduled home transportation (approximately 2:15 p.m.). This means that if your child needs to leave prior to the end of program (5:15 dismissal) the parent or guardian will need to coordinate transportation.
- Students in Kindergarten and Grade 1 will need to be picked up by a parent or guardian at dismissal of the after school program at their program site.

Dinner will be provided for all students during program hours. The program will offer academic support as well as mindfulness and enrichment activities. The Troy YMCA and Troy Boys and Girls Club will be providing enrichment programming.

Program is scheduled to begin **September 11, 2018** and will run through **June 20, 2019.** If you are interested, please complete the attached application and return to your child's school or the ESASP office. You will be notified by letter if your child has been accepted. If you have questions please feel free to contact me.
