# **Third Grade Supply List**

Your child will need the items below for third grade at School 14 in Troy. Please make sure he/she brings the supplies to school on the first day of school. The items need to have your child's first and last names written on them with permanent marker.

#### **SUPPLIES NEEDED:**

- 4 composition notebooks (black & white style notebook, any color)
- 2 one-subject notebooks, wide ruled (1 Blue, 1 choice)
- 5 two-pocket <u>plastic folders</u> (specific colors: 1 Red, 1 Green, 1 Blue, 1 Yellow, 1 Choice)
- **48 SHARPENED** #2 pencils to begin the year with (Additional pencils will be needed throughout the year.)
- Erasers
- 2 highlighters
- 4 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of crayons (no larger than a box of 24)
- 1 box of *washable* colored markers (no larger than a box of 12)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pack (100) white lined index cards
- 1 pack of Loose-leaf paper (wide ruled)
- 1 *SMALL* pencil box (to store pencils, glue sticks, crayons, scissors, and highlighters)
- 4 LARGE boxes of tissues
- 4 Dry-erase markers
- 2 4 packs (or more) of 3" x 3" Post-it notes (Sticky notes)
- 2 Sharpie markers (Black)
- 1 set of headphones (MUST HAVE) labeled in a ziplock bag
- 1 LARGE bottle of Hand Sanitizer
- 1 package of Wet Wipes
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- 1 box of Ziploc Bags (Boys gallon sized, Girls Sandwich sized)
