A. Bid Awards - Capital Project

1. Asbestos Abatement

RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, that the bid for Contract No. 1, Project No. 49-17-00-01-0-012-014 for Asbestos Abatement be awarded to Danair, Inc., in the amount of \$237,000, their being the lowest qualified bidder meeting specifications at the bid opening on November 2, 2011.

2. General Construction

RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, that the bid for Contract No. 2, Project No. 49-17-00-01-0-012-014 for General Construction be awarded to Sano-Rubin Construction Co., Inc., in the amount of \$23,470,000, their being the lowest qualified bidder meeting specifications at the bid opening on November 2, 2011.
