ABOUT THE 2013-14 SCHOOL BUDGET

The Troy City School District has put forth a budget to voters that is:

- ► fiscally responsible and below tax cap
- ► maintains programs for students
- ► true to Troy's mission statement

Fast Facts:

► Proposed Budget: \$97,428,554

► Proposed Tax Levy: 2.99% (\$340,000 below tax cap)

- ► Strong advocacy efforts resulted in State Aid increase = \$650,000
- ➤ No full-time employee layoffs; 5 positions reduced through retirements or attrition
- ► Cuts limited to 1 foreign language (3 languages remain) and Drug-Free Program in elementary schools (program remains in Middle School and High School)
- ▶ If the budget is not passed by voters, an additional \$992,554 must be cut from the budget which would have a devastating impact on our students.
