District Odyssey of the Mind Coordinator and THS Teacher, Andy Bettinger, gave a brief overview of the OM program. He explained that Odyssey of the Mind is an international creative problemsolving competition that engages students in Grades K-12 and allows their learning to come to life. There are four levels: Primary (Grades K-2); Level 1 (Grades 3-5); Level 2 (Greades 6-8); and Level 3 (Grades 9-12). Teams must give a creative presentation to solve a problem within 8 minutes. Mr. Bettinger thanked the Board for their support over the past nine years; 600 students have been involved in OM across the District. School 18 will go to the world finals for the first time.

<u>School 18 OM Team is NYS Champions and will advance to world finals in May</u>. The following students made an outstanding OM presentation: Georgia Dunbar, May Dunbar, Dawson Fera, Finnegan Fronhofer, Kaylee Kussler, Ryan Maloney and Lauren Matthews.
