II. Non-Action Items

A. Carroll Hill School Principal's Presentation

Mr. Roy Stiles, CHS Principal, gave a power point presentation. He reviewed CHS building goals in place for the past three years. CHS designation has been changed from "Priority School" to "Targeted Support and Improvement School". Mr. Stiles said the TSI designation remains for Special Education subgroup and CHS is making good progress. He reported that CHS is improving in ELA scores and trending in the right direction, including an increase in Level 4s. Discipline data YTD is down 30%. Second Step and SAEBRS character ed programs are making a difference. Teachers are committed to professional development and they are grateful for early release days. CHS is very happy to be a project school. There are 120 students in the Empire State afterschool program which provides academic enrichment. CHS is applying technology to instruction with virtual field trips, coding, robots and spheres. Parents are getting involved with app. Mr. Tuttman asked if parents are actually participating with the app. Mr. Stiles said almost all parents are signed up for the app and approximately half are commenting. Mr. Mayo said it is nice to see the scores going up.
