A. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 5:30 pm Mr. Mayo, President, made a motion for Executive Session for discussion of pending litigation. Invited in were Mr. Carmello, Mr. Hotaling, Dr. Watson and Ms. Ahearn.

B. PUBLIC SESSION

At 6:00 pm Mr. Mayo called the regular meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no district announcements.

Mr. Carmello thanked for voters for passing the budget with 80% approval. He congratulated Mrs. Apicella and Mrs. Wager-Rounds on their re-election. He thanked Mr. Tuttman for his service on the Board. He stated he is looking forward to working with new Board member Mrs. Ebony Pompey-Conway.

C. PUBLIC INPUT ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS

Richard Ellis (taxpayer) - Mr. Ellis stated he votes every year for the budget; however, he was unable to vote on May 21 because there was not parking at School 18 even after driving around for ten minutes. School 18 held a family picnic which may get parents out to vote but it limits seniors' accessibility to the polling site. He asked that if school events are planned on vote day to please designate parking spaces specifically for voters.
