A. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 5:00 pm Mr. Mayo, President, made a motion for Executive Session for discussion of pending litigation. Invited in were Mr. Carmello, Dr. Watson, Mr. Hotaling, Mrs. Miaski and Ms. Ahearn.

At 5:15 pm the Board held a reception in the WK Doyle Media Center at TMS to meet and greet District administrators.

B. PUBLIC SESSION

At 6:05 pm Mr. Mayo called the regular meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

C. PUBLIC INPUT ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS

There was no public comment.

II. Non-Action Items

A. Update on Capital Projects

Mr. Kiersten Lorcher (Mosaic Architects) gave a report on the School 2 Community Schools Capital Project. He said the Community Schools wing is complete; the health care center is in progress. School 2 bridge windows are in place temporarily; permanent windows are on order.

HVAC is complete at Troy Middle School; includes hot water piece.

The steam to hot water conversion at Troy High School has been built. In the winter, both water systems will be working. THS pool is closed and ceiling is being replaced and completed in the next few days. We will continue steam to hot water conversion into Spring 2019 and completed in Summer 2019.

THS Roof - During this summer it was discovered that Troy High's roof needs major structural repair. Past roof repairs were never properly addressed; only repeated additional layers installed. Mr. Carmello added that the roof was looked at during the building condition survey; now it is a priority. Jeff West (UW Marx) also stated that the current roof is 14 years old and leaks; flood coat is dilapidated. Mr. Hotaling said we are asking the Board to start the investigation process; he is concerned there may be more problems than it appears.

Capital Project - Mr. Carmello recommends we have another Capital Project to repair the THS roof. He feels because of the urgency of the roof's condition we should not wait to tie this vote in with the May vote. The Board would need to give approval at the October 17th meeting for a possible December vote. There are funds in the Capital Reserve fund so that there would be no cost to the taxpayers. Mrs. Wager-Rounds said if we vote strictly on the roof; we have a good chance of approval and can begin work in the summer. Mr. Carmello would like to have cost of the entire roof by first October meeting so Board can vote on it at the October 17th meeting.

Mrs. Fitch asked Mr. Lorcher if he could determine the cause of the damage to the roof to prevent future problems. Mr. Hotaling stated it is likely attributed to the fact that the roof was never repaired properly 14 years ago, probably due to budget restrictions, and new layers have been added over old layers when the original roof should have been replaced. Mr. Lorcher concluded by saying there are several items at different buildings that need to be re-bid this fall; items are already in the budget.
