A. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 5:30 pm Mr. Mayo, President, made a motion for Executive Session for discussion of pending litigation. Invited in were Mr. Carmello, Dr. Watson, Mr. Hotaling, Mrs. Miaski and Mrs. O'Grady-Parent.

B. PUBLIC SESSION

At 6:10 pm Mr. Mayo called the regular meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. District Announcements included: (1) School 16 held a telethon with WRGB-Channel 6, the Regional Food Bank of Northeastern New York and Fidelis Care to benefit the Backpack Program and raised \$13,000 to help benefit our neediest students; (2) congratulations to the Troy High School Quiz Bowl Team (aka The MasterMinds) who came in second place at the tournament; team now qualified for nationals in Atlanta; and (3) congratulations to Troy High senior Amaya George, recipient of the Spectrum News Scholar Athlete of the Week and awarded \$1,000 scholarship.

C. PUBLIC HEARING FOR CHARTER RENEWAL APPLICATION - TROY PREP

Mr. Carmello opened the public hearing regarding the True North Troy Preparatory Charter School has submitted an application to renew their charter. He said there is currently approximately 400 Troy students attending this charter school which is a drain on our budget and he wishes charter schools were funded in another way. Mr. Carmello asked for public comment.

No comments were received on the charter application.

II. Non-Action Items

A. TMS Principal's Presentation - I. McShane

Mr. Ian McShane, new Troy Middle School principal, gave a power point presentation. He thanked the Board and Administration for the opportunity to be TMS principal. He has great confidence in his TMS team who he works with every day. He stated that TMS is on a mission to grow academically and build strong character; together we will create opportunities that shape our future. We want to make sure each student knows that TMS is about their future. Our students are valued and we want them to be confident.

Mr. McShane said that TMS staff has a narrow focus that targets key areas, measuring results and assessing strategies. Maintaining a positive school culture is essential to growth; there are high expectations. He is grateful to staff who worked hard this summer to prepare for the new school year and restructured the master schedule that worked best for our students.
