B. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 6:15 pm Mr. Schofield made a motion for Executive Session for pending litigation. Invited in were Mr. Carmello, Mr. Hotaling, Ms. Miaski and Ms. Ahearn.

D. PUBLIC HEARING ON TRUE NORTH TROY PREP CHARTER SCHOOL

Mr. Carmello explained we are holding tonight's public hearing in response to another request from North Troy Preparatory Charter School. Troy Prep has made a charter revision request to amend their admissions policy so that its at-risk admissions factors, or "preferences", include a 20% set-aside for English Language Learners for incoming students. Mr. Tuttman asked if ELL students are considered "at risk". Ms. Ahearn replied yes, according to the charter requirements.

Mr. Carmello asked for public comments on this matter. There were no public comments made.

II. Non-Action Items

A. TREASURER'S REPORT

November 2016 Financials - Mrs. Sarah Conyers, District Treasurer, reported for November that budget transfers were primarily salary-related, property tax refunds due to assessment changes and new Special Education placements coming into the District. The internal auditor reviewed 404 claims which totaled approximately \$4.8 million.

<u>General Fund</u> - Revenues compare to the same time last year. We are still waiting for Bullet Aid. Expenditures show an increase due to interfund transfers to the capital fund of \$3.5 million. There were also property tax refunds. Fifteen grants have been approved and two are under review. Mrs. Conyers will begin projections for December board reports.

Treasurer's Report - All accounts have been reconciled.
