B. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 5:30 pm Mr. Mayo made a motion for Executive Session for pending litigation. Invited in were Mr. Carmello, Mr. Hotaling and Mrs. O'Grady-Parent. Mr. Schofield was not present for Executive Session.

C. PUBLIC SESSION

At 6:00 pm Mr. Schofield called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no District announcements. However, Mr. Carmello made a statement regarding interest in creating a Boys' Swim Team. He has met with Mr. Reinisch and Mr. Schofield on this matter; he will attend the Booster Club meeting for open discussion.

D. PUBLIC INPUT ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS NON-ACTION ITEMS

Daniel Greene (THS Senior) - He has been a swimmer for ten years. Establishing a varsity swim team for boys would a good program for a lot of kids and he would like the chance to represent his team since it is his last year at THS.

Nikita Padunin (THS Sophomore) - He has been a swimmer for five years. He has wanted to continue to swim for Troy but there is only a varsity team for girls.

Nathan Greene (THS Freshman) - He has been swimming competitively for seven years. It would be good to bring back a boys' varsity swim team so middle school students to continue to swim for the high school. It is also good for students to gain new relationships.

II. Non-Action Items

A. District Transportation - M. Loccisano

Mr. Mario Loccisano, Transportation Coordinator, gave a report of District transportation. There are approximately 5,000 students who are transported daily; 4,000 in District and 1,000 in private/parochial schools with 36 locations. There is an average of 75 McKinney-Vento students who are also transported and this number fluctuates on a daily basis. Eighty-four busses are on the road each day not including sports and field trips. Afterschool transportation includes 21st Century program and two late buses for detention or for students staying after school for help. For 2016-17 there were 750 sporting events and field trips.

Mr. Loccisano begins to prepare for a new school year in February-March. April 1st is the deadline for transportation request forms. May and June are focused on in-district summer programs. Bus schedules are mailed to parents in August. A mock start up day is held for bus drivers to practice runs of their routes.

<u>Discussion:</u> Mrs. Harvin asked if all buses have monitors and video taping devices - Yes for both; video records continuously. Are their seatbelts on the buses? Yes but we cannot buckle the seat belt for students. Mr. Schofield asked about Durham staffing (it was short for several years) - No real issues any longer. Mrs. Wager-Rounds said we used to get regular complaints about transportation but it is so nice to see everything running smoothly because of Mr. Loccisano.

B. Policy Review - J. Carmello

Mr. Carmello reported on the Policy Committee held on September 20.

1230 Public Participation at Board Meetings - policy was reviewed; no changes made. 1530 Smoking and Other Tobacco Use on School Premises - policy updated to include language regarding e-cigarettes.

5460 Child Abuse, Maltreatment or Neglect in a Domestic Setting - policy was updated regarding hotline number for child abuse. District posts phone number on the website.
