B. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 6:30 pm Mr. Schofield called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Schofield read the following announcements: (1) Section 2 Class AA Superbowl is this Friday, November 3 at 7 p.m. against Saratoga Springs at UAlbany; and (2) Governor Andrew Cuomo welcomed Troy High School teacher Justin Haviland to the Master Teacher Program for his work in stem cell and genetic mutation research.

II. Non-Action Items

A. School Board Recognition - J. Carmello

Mr. Carmello said he was honored and grateful to work with Troy's Board of Education. Appreciation posters and cards from the elementary schools were displayed at the meeting in the Troy Room.

B. Technology Presentation - E. Sheevers

Ms. Erin Sheevers, Director of Technology, gave a presentation regarding the District's technology. Ms. Sheevers said the Technology Capital Project (vote held December 2013) allowed Troy to upgrade its infrastructure and technology. We have been able to get devices into every students' hands (elementary and TMS with carts by grade level; THS student by subject). All students are using chromebooks daily. Every teacher has a mobile device. Thank you to Mary Marro-Giroux who is a member of Technology Committee and helped with the District Technology Plan.

New technology includes upgrades THS media studio to live announcements; a lot with coding and robotics was purchased for every building; robotics fits into the curriculum. This is year 2 for Minecraft and Gaming program at School 18; thank you to Bill Strang for its success. There is a significant increase in number of virtual field trips since the District has received MX800s. Data dashboards are used by staff to implement daily lessons. We made sure the device is purposeful and effective as well as rigorous and aligned to the curriculum; we are working closely with teachers and technology coaches.

Other programs include Summer Tech Camp attended by 120 teachers; digital citizenship course held for students to ensure online safety; and we are going to offer technology support for parents as well.

The District's hardware and infrastructure is robust; very reliable and safe. Tens of thousands of attacks are prevented daily. We also have a robust plan for the end of life for our devices to be phased out.

Mrs. Samantha Schweizer, District Treasurer, reported on the September financials. She stated the General Fund balance is the same as last year. Grants were submitted by August 30th deadline and all accounts reconciled. There were no questions.
