# I. Call to Order

## B. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 5:30 pm Mr. Schofield made a motion for Executive Session for an employee disciplinary matter and pending litigation. Invited in were Mr. Carmello, Dr. Watson, Mr. Hotaling, Mrs. Miaski and M Ahearn.

## C. PUBLIC SESSION

At 6:10 pm Mr. Schofield called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Schofield read the following announcements: The New York State Education Department released the 2017 Graduation Rates last week. At 86 percent, Troy High School has gone up 3 percentage points from 2016 and a full 10 percentage points from 2015. In addition, the achievement gap has also been eliminated. We are pleased to announce that Troy is a recipient of the Empire State After School Grant. The grant allows for each District elementary school to host its own after school program, resulting in additional learning time for students; program will begin January 16.

## II. Non-Action Items

## A. School 2 Principal's Report - N. Turner-Hassell

Principal Natélegé Turner-Hassell gave a power point presentation regarding School 2. School 2 has been designated as a Priority School and in receivership status. ELA efficiency scores have increased from 10% to 15.2% since last year; Math has shown steady progress from 9% to 14.7%; their goal is 20%. School 2 has met 9 of the 11 demonstrable improvement indicators and was congratulated by Commissioner Elia for this progress.

Mrs. Turner-Hassell said she is proud of these accomplishments but understands there is much work to be done. There are so many people supporting School 2 and good systems are in place: School 2 has a healthy school culture and climate; a shared vision and mission; multiple resources such as consultants, teacher-leaders and professional development; efficacy mindset; student support team indicatives; and committed faculty and staff. She reviewed School 2 building goals established by the School Improvement Grant and said there is a laser focus on creating a culture of learning among faculty and staff; increasing student intellectual engagement and achieving; seeing data as a point of inquiry; and reflection to responsiveness. She thanked her faculty/staff, the Board of Education, District administration and her family for their support.

## B. School 2 Community Schools Project - A. Hotaling

Mr. Adam Hotaling, Assistant Superintendent for Business, reported that School 2 was awarded approximately \$550,000 Community Schools Grant. He presented information regarding the capital improvement portion of the grant. NYS budget appropriated \$75 million state-wide and Troy was 1 of approximately 20 schools awarded money across the state. This is a one-year grant from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 which is a very tight window to act on funds. Approximately \$180,000 was allocated for capital improvement at School 2. This is a rare opportunity for School 2 and the District with no impact on the taxpayer. We will be able to construct a Community Schools wing with mental health services in the building. Construction will begin in the summer of 2018 and last 10 months.
