# I. Call to Order

At 5:30 pm Mr. Schofield, Board President, called the meeting to order.

## C. PUBLIC SESSION

At 6:00 pm Mr. Schofield called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

<u>Announcements:</u> (1) The District launched a new website on December 9; (2) Taina Rivera and Kayana Santana, 3rd Grade students from School 14, earned third place in the Cool Kid IP Challenge Powered by AT&T, a regional invention competition held at RPI.

## C. PUBLIC HEARING ON TRUE NORTH TROY PREP CHARTER SCHOOL

Mr. Carmello opened the public hearing, stating that True North Troy Preparatory Charter School has requested a Grade 9-12 extension beginning with Grade 9 in fall 2017. Mr. Carmello said Troy CSD remains the best place for Troy families to educate their children. Troy High School provides advanced placement classes, multiple college offerings, as well as an extensive list of clubs and extracurricular activities.

## II. Non-Action Items

## A. PRINCIPAL'S PRESENTATION - N. Turner-Hassell

School 2 Principal Natélegé Turner-Hassell gave a power point presentation entitled "Sincerely Yours" to illustrate the great work being done with their students. There are three intentional focus areas at School 2: (1) involving and sustaining a healthy culture and climate (2) enhancing learning and instruction, and (3) engaging and building relationships with families and community members. School 2 is much more than numbers and data is used for feedback. Data was shared with parents at the recent open house. Central Office has been very supportive by providing School 2 with math and reading consultants and experts from the SUNY Research Institute.

The learning environment includes reading blocks, math intervention and afterschool enrichment programs. School 2 is a community school with resources in transportation, physical and mental health. NYSUT provided home visit training this summer. Mrs. Turner-Hassell feels she has the best staff.

<u>Discussion</u>: Mrs. Harvin asked about the parent attendance at School 2's open house. Mrs. Turner-Hassell said attendance was very high but more parents attended during the half-day session. Mr. Tuttman commended School 2 for fewer referrals which were reduced to less than 10%; in previous years parents have complained about poor student behavior. Mr. Carmello added that he is very proud of the evolution taking place at School 2 over the past three years under Mrs. Turner-Hassell and Mr. Meadows' leadership.
