I. Call to Order

At 6:00 pm Mr. Schofield, Board President, called the meeting to order.

B. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 6:00 pm Mr. Schofield made a motion for Executive Session for pending litigation. Invited in were Mr. Carmello, Dr. Watson, Mr. Hotaling, Ms. Miaski and Mrs. O'Grady-Parent.

C. PUBLIC SESSION

At 6:35 pm Mr. Schofield called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Schofield announced that the District has launched an advocacy campaign whereby community members are asked to sign pre-written letters to legislators asking for equitable state aid. Letters were sent home to parents and can also be found on our website.

II. Non-Action Items

A. Treasurer's Report

<u>January 2017 Financials</u> - Mrs. Sarah Conyers, District Treasurer, reported that budget transfers are mainly salary related and due to an increase from BOCES adjustments since the beginning of the school year. The internal auditor reviewed 535 claims totaling \$4 million. There are two grants under review and all accounts have reconciled.

In the General Fund there is a slight increase from Decembers' projections. Revenue aid projections are up for building aid from final cost reports submitted in December for \$8.4 million Capital Project.

B. Capital Project Update

Mr. Adam Hotaling, Assistant Superintendent for Business, reported that the Capital Project Committee has been meeting every two weeks. Phase I bid is going out this week for windows and roofs. Phase II for HVAC will start the following summer. He stated certain items have come up during committee discussions which are not included in the \$23.3 million bond: (1) no storage space, (2) inadequate classroom space, (3) School 16 ADA compliance and (4) use of space for closed pools.

Mr. Carmello added there was originally \$50 million needed for repairs and upgrades but only \$23 million was covered by the Capital Project. We know there are still areas needing attention outside of the scope of the Capital Project. Ms. Marro-Giroux appreciated using the one-time money quickly so we could take advantage of savings. She asked if there any other one-revenues in the future. Mr. Hotaling said we may want to establish a Capital Reserve fund in this year's budget to cover the stakeholder's share. Mrs. Wager-Rounds said we are not putting band aids on anything. We are getting things lined up for the next step. Mr. Lorcher joined the meeting and reported that the Zak House parking lot is being used and the final pavement will be completed as soon as the asphalt company re-opens in spring.
