#### **B. EXECUTIVE SESSION**

#### C. PUBLIC SESSION

At 6:10 pm Mr. Schofield called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### D. SUPERINTENDENT'S FACILITIES REPORT

Mr. Carmello stated this has been a difficult week for District facilities. The building condition surveys showed District buildings are in need of repair and we tried to be proactive with the Infrastructure Update Capital Project. Unfortunately, yesterday we noticed that some tiles were falling into the THS pool and it has been closed. Mr. Kiersten Lorcher of Mosaic Architects provided further details: upon inspection it was determined there were several sags in the ceiling and the suspension wires are corroded and broken. This has been determined to be an emergency situation for safety reasons. SED and a contractor have been contacted. Mr. Carmello added the District will get 80% in aid back next year on an emergency project such as this.

<u>Discussion:</u> Mr. Tuttman asked if the roof was intact. Mr. Lorcher responded yes. It appears that chlorine in the pool is aggressive on stainless steel but the primary structure appears to be fine.

# 1. <u>RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY PROJECT</u>

WHEREAS, a portion of the ceiling over the pool in the Troy High School has WHEREAS, as a result of the condition of the ceiling, the pool is un-useable; and

WHEREAS, the condition of the ceiling is an emergency that requires immediate remediation to preserve the property of the School District and to assure the health and safety of students and staff of the School District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the School District desires to approve the repair and replacement of the ceiling over the pool in the Troy High School (the "Project"), an ordinary and contingent expense; and

WHEREAS, voter approval is not required with respect to the expenditure of funds to pay ordinary contingent expenses;

WHEREAS, the proposed Project entails the construction, maintenance, repair, replacement, reconstruction and/or rehabilitation involving no substantial changes or expansion beyond 10,000 square feet of existing structures and/or facilities; and WHEREAS, the proposed Project is a routine activity of the School District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has considered the information and documentation, which describes the design and intent of the Project;

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE TROY CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Education, based upon the record before it and the general, specific and detailed knowledge of the Board of Education of the proposed Project and under the applicable standards of SEQRA and 6 NYCRR Part 617.5, hereby determines that the Project is a Type II Action, and that no further action is required to satisfy the requirements of the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Section 2. The Board of Education hereby determines that the condition of the ceiling over the pool in the Troy High School is an emergency condition that requires immediate remediation in order to preserve School District property and to assure the health and safety of students and staff.

Section 3. The Board of Education hereby determines that the Project is an ordinary contingent expense that is necessary to preserve property and to assure the health and safety of students and staff.

Section 4. Due to such unanticipated ordinary contingent expenses, \$500,000 of undesignated fund balance or such amount as shall be necessary shall be transferred into the general fund for such emergency purpose.

Section 5. The 2017-2018 general fund budget is hereby increased by an amount not to exceed \$500,000 to accommodate this unanticipated expenditure.

Section 6. The Assistant Superintendent for Business is hereby authorized to file the necessary and proper paperwork with the State Education Department to proceed with the Project.

Section 7. The Assistant Superintendent for Business is hereby authorized to work with the School District's architect to immediately prepare bid specifications.

Section 8. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
