## 1. Retention/Destruction of 2019 Vote Ballots

WHEREAS, at least six (6) months has elapsed from the date of the Annual Budget Vote and Election held on May 21, 2019 and no proceedings have been commenced with regard to such Annual Budget Vote and Election; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Enlarged City School District of Troy hereby orders the destruction of all unused, defective, void and/or spoiled ballots resulting from the May 21, 2019 Annual Budget Vote and Election.
