A. Superintendent Update - J. Carmello

Mr. Carmello speaks about the excitement with the students and staff returning back to school. There has been a glitch regarding transportation, but this is not exclusive to Troy. It is happening across the country. The National Guard was called in Massachusetts to serve as bus drivers. We are hopeful that more drivers will be hired over

the next week or two. We also have plans in place to help communicate any transportation issues.

## B. Capital Project Update - Adam Hotaling, Jeff West, Henry Albarelli

Mr. Hotaling shared a presentation about past capital projects and current capital projects. He explains that the work being done at Carroll Hill School has been substantially completed. The year-long work has begun at the Troy Community School (TCS) with an expected completion date of Fall 2022. School 12's pool area demolition has begun and work will continue to be done to reach our anticipated completion date of Fall 2022. School 14's project was by far the most difficult project to take on this summer. Due to COVID, there were supply chain issues, employment shortages across all industries which delayed so many items. The project has added classroom walls, revamped the common area and is working on a secure vestibule. Due to the extreme dedication of many employees and long hours we were able to open School 14 on time for our students. At this point, everything is going as planned on the timetable for each of our projects.
