A. October Financials - S. Schweizer

Ms. Schweizer explained that transfers were minimal, just recoding of purchasing for building and facilities. The Auditor reviewed \$10.3M in claims this month, with the addition of school lunch claims. Revenue in the general fund is a little less than last year based on timing of state aid payments. The expenditures are reduced from last year but consistent with October 2019-20. Last year expenditures were increased due to PPE and reopening

spending. School lunch expenditures and revenues are both increased from prior years based on timing of federal reimbursement and expenditures are new for food purchases. We have started to receive initial payments for our new year grants. All bank accounts have been reconciled.

B. Carroll Hill School Presentation - R. Stiles

Four Carroll Hill students started off the presentation explaining what makes Carroll Hill special to them. Some things discussed were the teachers and staff. Another spoke about the community at Carroll Hill encourages students to share their passions during morning meetings with their peers. The students also expressed their love for STEAM days, using robots, octobots and virtual reality goggles. The students as well as Mr. Stiles thank the Board for always supporting their interests at Carroll Hill and always giving them opportunities to grow as learners.
