B. Public Session

At 6:01 pm Mrs. Wager-Rounds called the regular meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

D. Public Input on agenda and non-agenda items non-action items:

Mr. Anthony Cerulli, 24 Horton Ave, spoke about the ongoing transportation issue for his daughter at School 18. He states that every day the bus is late, combined or does not show up. He waits until the last minute at the bus stop, then ultimately has to drive her to school and be late for work himself. He is hoping that the district can come up with some solution. Mr. Hotaling added that the district is well aware of the transportation issue and is just as frustrated as he is with the situation. He goes on to explain that this is a national problem of bus driver shortages. Mr. Hotaling encourages parents who do not use the bus, but have reserved a seat for their child on the bus, to let transportation know. That will help eliminate stops where children never get on the bus and hopefully make the bus not run as late.

II. Non-Action Items

A. Capital Project Presentation - A. Hotaling

Mr. Hotaling gave an overview of the ongoing building modernization capital project, which voters approved in December 2019. He spoke about the items that have been completed such as purchasing the NEFF Center with current renovation for the Troy Community School, adding classroom walls to School 14 over the summer, Carroll Hill had windows replaced and classroom HVAC, and renovations at School 12 are currently being done to transform the pool area into office spaces. Moving into Phase III of this project brings us to Summer 2022 through September 2023. During this phase, the School 12 ALP will move to the Troy Community School, Central Registration and Special Education offices will permanently move to the renovated pool area space of School 12

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and School 18 will relocate to School 12 so that their building can undergo a heating and ventilation system renovation. All School 18 students will be eligible for bus transportation during this phase of the project. Phase IV is set to start Summer 2023 through September 2024, when School 18 will move back to their building, and School 16 will move down to School 12 for their ADA compliance renovation. All School 16 students will be eligible for bus transportation during this phase of the project. The high school tech wing is also included in this project, and will likely take place during the 2023-2024 school year.
