**PROGRAM OVERVIEW:** The first year of Regeneron's four-year program will focus on building relationships and developing a close-knit community where students will feel a sense of belonging and connection with both their peers and their Regeneron volunteers/mentors. Participants will also learn about careers at Regeneron and how concepts taught in the classroom are used in 'real-world' applications.

**RESPONIBILITIES:**

- Recruitment Cycle: September 2022- December 2022
- September – December, working with the 10<sup>th</sup> grade advisor to transition current-former cohort
- Attend Parent-Teacher Nights and meet with prospective students
- Post Regeneron STEM Academy Applications at the end of October- deadline will be mid-November
- Accepted students will announced in early December and 9<sup>th</sup> grade cohort will begin their program in January 2023
- The 9<sup>th</sup> grader cohort will follow a similar curriculum from the previous year and advisor will work with students and Regeneron staff to implement the curriculum outside the school day. Given the program is new, advisors will work to tailor to program/curriculum to fit the needs of the students.
- Advisors will coordinate and supervise off-campus trips as well as Regeneron Site visits.
