- Work closely with APT to offer counseling, and SEL strategies.
- Collaborate with social workers and school psychologists to plan and facilitate group and individual counseling.
- Manage an assigned caseload of students to ensure students are logging on for instruction and completing assignments.
- Collaborate with the classroom teacher to identify student needs (i.e. missing work, gaps in learning, etc.).
- Help students in developing organizational skills and using available technology effectively.
- Monitor students' academic performance, attendance and assignment completion.
- Develop relationships with students to increase their overall success in school.
- Collect information on students' interests and struggles either academically, social, emotionally or behaviorally.
- Assist in constructing a plan for student improvement and success.
- Collaborate to plan and implement group activities.
