B. Public Session

At 6:04pm Mrs. Wager-Rounds called the regular meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Non-Action Items

A. Audit Discussion - D. Gabel, EFPR Group

Mr. Gabel from the EFPR Group met with the Audit Committee prior to the Board meeting to discuss in greater detail the findings of the external audit. He briefly explains his findings stating that they identify significant areas and controls and test the effectiveness of the controls. Based on the tests and audit procedures, EFPR Group issued a positive opinion on these reports based on financial statements and have unmodified opinions. All records and information requested were issued and the team did a great job answering all questions.

B. Principal's Presentation - A. Klopott

Ms. Klopott begins her presentation thanking the Board and Cabinet Administration for their continued support at School 2. She goes on to show the latest NYS ELA and Math testing results which showed increases from last year. Ms. Klopott explains there are steps to success and they have a strong focus on attendance. This year they monitor daily attendance rates which have not dropped below 90% for the month of September. Another initiative is building a stronger relationship with the community through home visits, regular communication with families, and building formal partnerships with organizations such as Sage College, SNUG, Troy PD Reading

Buddies and much more. The final initiative this year is using data to drive instruction. This happens with weekly data meetings with teachers, embedded professional development and students tracking their own data. Ms. Klopott explains that all of these initiatives will make positive impacts at School 2 this year.
