


#### Number of Students Scoring at Proficient level - Pre-Pandemic






#### TCSD ELA Proficiency Performance – by School





### TCSD Math Proficiency Performance – by School















### Highlights

- Continued our district-wide trend of increased student performance
  - Proficiency in Math increasing by 11% over last year
  - Proficiency in ELA increased by 6.7% over last year
- Every school in the District increased proficiency rates in both ELA and Math
- District proficiency rates well above the pre-pandemic proficiency rates in both ELA and Math
- Four of our six schools with Grades 3-8 testing had a double-digit ELA proficiency rate increase
  - PS 16 highest with 22% increase
- Three out of our six schools had a double-digit Math proficiency rate increase
  - TMS highest percent increase at 16%
- PS 14 double digit percent increase in both ELA and Math
- PS 2 recorded their highest percent proficiency rates in both ELA and Math
- PS 16 outperformed the State proficiency rate in both ELA and Math
- We are significantly outperforming similar need districts
