III. Action Items

- A. Feasibility Study Findings

WHEREAS, at their joint meeting on August 13, 2025, the Boards of Education of the Enlarged City School District of Troy ("Troy") and the Wynantskill Union Free School District ("Wynantskill") authorized the pursuit of a comprehensive reorganization Feasibility Study to be undertaken jointly, to include the engagement of appropriate consultants, the collection and analysis of relevant data, and collaboration with stakeholders from both districts;

WHEREAS, following an RFP process facilitated by Questar III BOCES, the Schmitt Leadership Group was selected to conduct the Feasibility Study;

WHEREAS, following a comprehensive review that included more than 2,200 community and stakeholder engagements, the Schmitt Leadership Group completed its Feasibility Study, which contained a preliminary recommendation to proceed with a public vote for annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study report has been made available to both Boards and to their respective communities for review;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that both boards have reviewed the Feasibility Study report and agree with and hereby accept the findings and recommendations set forth therein;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that both boards direct their respective Superintendents to take the steps necessary to achieve consolidation between Troy and Wynantskill, including but not limited to, obtaining the approval of the qualified voters of Wynantskill at a special meeting to be hereafter authorized by the Wynantskill Board of Education.
